



## ENTRY REQUIREMENTS FOR VISITORS FROM INDIA

AS OF MARCH 1, 2022

### CHANGES FROM THE LAST VERSION:

- Vaccinated people do not need a PCR test to enter Romania
- Entry to Bulgaria was only possible from Romania, but is now possible also from other countries
- Bulgaria and Romania updated vaccine list
- Austria updated list of vaccines. They have two lists, one to enter the country and one within the country (to enter restaurants, hotels).
- Croatia has Novavax on approved vaccine list. Validity of vaccine was reduced from 365 days to 270 days.
- Italy is open for leisure visitors from all countries

### COUNTRIES ARE INTRODUCED IN REVERSE CLOCKWISE ORDER

North from Slovenia, Croatia then South to Albania, North Macedonia and finishing with Romania and Serbia. You will also find Austria and Italy at the bottom of the file.

### SLOVENIA

<b>Is entry possible?</b>	Yes, entry is possible for non-essential travel.
<b>Do vaccinated visitors need additional testing?</b>	No, vaccination is sufficient.
<b>Which vaccinations are approved?</b>	Comirnaty (Biontech/Pfizer) or Spikevax (Moderna) or the Sputnik V (Russia's Gamaleya National Centre of Epidemiology and Microbiology) or the CoronaVac (Sinovac Biotech) or the Sinopharm or the Vaxzevria (AstraZeneca) or Covishield (Serum Institute of India/AstraZeneca) or the Covaxin (Bharat Biotech of India) or Janssen (Johnson/Janssen-Cilag) or a combination of two previously listed vaccines.
<b>What kind of certificate is acceptable?</b>	One of bellow: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- EU digital certificate</li><li>- Digital certificate of third country</li></ul>



	- Certification of vaccination, vaccine booklet etc are also accepted.
<b>Validity of vaccine?</b>	270 days.
<b>Can non-vaccinated guests enter?</b>	Yes, as long as they have PCR or antigen test or proof of recovery.
<b>Other things we need to know?</b>	PCR and antigen tests from India are not acceptable. Testing has to be done in EU and a couple of other countries. All visitors need to fill in Passenger locator form ( <a href="https://app.euplf.eu/#/">https://app.euplf.eu/#/</a> )

## CROATIA

<b>Is entry possible?</b>	Yes, entry is possible for non-essential travel as long as they have proof of accommodation booking.
<b>Do vaccinated visitors need additional testing?</b>	No, vaccination is sufficient.
<b>Which vaccinations are approved?</b>	EU approved vaccines (Pfizer, Moderna, AstaZeneca, Gamaleya, Sinopharm, Novavax) or vaccines approved by the World Health Organization for emergency use (Serum Institute of India - Covishield, Bharat Biotech - Covaxin, Sinovac – CoronaVac).
<b>Validity of vaccine?</b>	270 days.
<b>What kind of certificate is acceptable?</b>	EU digital certificate or certificate that has the following information included (type of vaccine, number of shots, date of last shot. Must be in English).
<b>Can non-vaccinated guests enter?</b>	Yes, as long as they have PCR (72 hours) or antigen test (48 hours) or proof of recovery.
<b>Other things we need to know?</b>	It is recommended to fill in Passenger locator form ( <a href="https://entercroatia.mup.hr/">https://entercroatia.mup.hr/</a> )

## BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA

<b>Is entry possible?</b>	Yes, entry is possible for non-essential travel.
<b>Do vaccinated visitors need additional testing?</b>	No, vaccination is sufficient.
<b>Which vaccinations are approved?</b>	Pfizer, Moderna, AstraZeneca, Gamaleya, Sinopharm, Serum Institute of India – Covishield, Bharat Biotech – Covaxin, Sinovac – CoronaVac).
<b>Validity of vaccine?</b>	
<b>What kind of certificate is acceptable?</b>	EU digital certificate or certificate that has the following information included (type of vaccine, number of shots, date of last shot. Must be in English).
<b>Can non-vaccinated guests enter?</b>	Yes, as long as they have PCR or antigen test. For visitors who arrive from European country (for example from Croatia) the test results is valid for 48 hours. From other countries it is valid for 72 hours. Certificate of overcoming is also sufficient (14 to 180 days).

## MONTENEGRO

<b>Is entry possible?</b>	Yes, entry is possible for non-essential travel.
<b>Do vaccinated visitors need additional testing?</b>	No, vaccination is sufficient.
<b>Which vaccinations are approved?</b>	Pfizer, Moderna, AstraZeneca, Gamaleya, Sinopharm, Serum Institute of India – Covishield, Bharat Biotech – Covaxin, Sinovac – CoronaVac).
<b>Validity of vaccine?</b>	Vaccine certificate if only valid for 6 months after the final shot. In case your final shot was administered more than 6 months ago make sure that you will either get a booster shot or do testing before visiting.
<b>What kind of certificate is</b>	EU digital certificate or certificate that has the following



acceptable?	information included (type of vaccine, number of shots, date of last shot. Must be in English).
Can non-vaccinated guests enter?	Yes, as long as they have negative PCR test (72 hours) or antigen rapid test-BAT (48 hours). Positive PCR or antigen test older than 10 days and not older than 6 months.

### ALBANIA

Is entry possible?	Yes, entry is possible for non-essential travel.
Do vaccinated visitors need additional testing?	No, vaccination is sufficient.
Which vaccinations are approved?	All vaccines are accepted.
What kind of certificate is acceptable?	EU digital certificate or certificate that has the following information included (type of vaccine, number of shots, date of last shot. Must be in English).
Can non-vaccinated guests enter?	Yes, as long as they have negative PCR test (72 hours) or antigen rapid test-BAT (48 hours) or evidence proving that you have recovered from Covid-19 within the last six months.
Other things we need to know?

### NORTH MACEDONIA

Is entry possible?	Yes, entry is possible for non-essential travel.
Do vaccinated visitors need	No, vaccination is sufficient.



<b>additional testing?</b>	
<b>Which vaccinations are approved?</b>	All vaccines are accepted.
<b>What kind of certificate is acceptable?</b>	EU digital certificate or certificate that has the following information included (type of vaccine, number of shots, date of last shot. Must be in English).
<b>Can non-vaccinated guests enter?</b>	Yes, as long as they have negative PCR test (72 hours) or antigen rapid test (48 hours) or evidence proving that you have recovered from Covid-19 within the 45 previous days.
<b>Other things we need to know?</b>

### KOSOVO

<b>Is entry possible?</b>	Yes, entry is possible for non-essential travel.
<b>Do vaccinated visitors need additional testing?</b>	No, vaccination is sufficient.
<b>Which vaccinations are approved?</b>	All vaccines are accepted. You can enter with a single shot, but you need to present negative PCR test or proof of recovery together with single dose.
<b>What kind of certificate is acceptable?</b>	EU digital certificate or certificate that has the following information included (type of vaccine, number of shots, date of last shot. Must be in English).
<b>Can non-vaccinated guests enter?</b>	No, you need to have at least one shot of the vaccine to be able to enter.
<b>Other things we need to know?</b>

### ROMANIA

<b>Is entry possible?</b>	Yes, entry is possible.

<b>Do vaccinated visitors need additional testing?</b>	No, fully vaccinated visitors do not need additional testing.
<b>Which vaccinations are approved?</b>	Romania approves Pfizer-BioNtech, AstraZeneca/Covishield, Moderna and Johnson&Johnson.
<b>Validity of vaccine?</b>	Vaccine is valid for 270 days. Booster shots are valid until December 31, 2022.
<b>What kind of certificate is acceptable?</b>	EU digital certificate or certificate that has the following information included (type of vaccine, number of shots, date of last shot. Must be in English).
<b>Can non-vaccinated guests enter?</b>	You can also enter with proof of recovery (180 days). If you enter with negative PCR test you need to quarantine for 5 days.
<b>Other things we need to know?</b>

## BULGARIA

<b>Is entry possible?</b>	Entry is possible.
<b>Do vaccinated visitors need additional testing?</b>	No, proof of vaccination is sufficient. Only people arriving from dark red countries (in Europe only Slovakia, Slovenia and Netherlands) require testing prior to entry.
<b>Which vaccinations are approved?</b>	BioNTech (Comirnaty), AstraZeneca (Vaxzevira), Moderna (Spikevax), Johnson & Johnson (Janssen), Serum Institute of India (Covishield & Covovax), Sinopharm, Sinovac, Sputnik, Novavax
<b>Validity of vaccine?</b>	270 days.
<b>What kind of certificate is acceptable?</b>	EU digital certificate or certificate that has the following information included (type of vaccine, number of shots, date of last shot. Must be in English).
<b>Can non-vaccinated guests enter?</b>	Yes, but only if they have negative PCR test or proof of overcoming Covid.
<b>Other things to know?</b>

## SERBIA

<b>Is entry possible?</b>	Entry is possible.
<b>Do vaccinated visitors need additional testing?</b>	Serbia only allows entry from countries with which they have an agreement. India has an agreement with Serbia and certificate of complete vaccination is sufficient to enter Serbia.
<b>Which vaccinations are approved?</b>	Because Serbia recognizes certificate of vaccination issued in India so all vaccines used in India are approved.
<b>What kind of certificate is acceptable?</b>	Certificate from India is recognized in Serbia and acceptable.
<b>Can non-vaccinated guests enter?</b>	Yes, you just need a negative PCR test results. Certificate of overcome Covid-19 issued in India is not recognized in Serbia and you would need to submit PCR test.
<b>Other things we need to know?</b>	Keep in mind that negative PCR test is required even for vaccinated guests.

## AUSTRIA

<b>Is entry possible?</b>	Entry is possible.
<b>Do vaccinated visitors need additional testing?</b>	No, additional testing is not required as of 22 February.
<b>Which vaccinations are approved?</b>	Austria approves the following vaccinations: BioNtech/Pfizer, AstraZeneca, Covishield, Covaxin, Nuvaxovid, Johnson & Johnson, Moderna, Sinovac, and Sinopharm
<b>What kind of certificate is acceptable?</b>	EU digital certificate or other certificate in English or German that includes same information as EU digital certificate.
<b>Validity of vaccination?</b>	Two-dose vaccinations are valid for 270 days after the second or any additional dose. There need to be at least 14 days in between the first and second jab and 90 days between the second and third one. Johnson & Johnson



	vaccination is valid for 270 days, 22 days after the first dose.
<b>Can non-vaccinated guests enter?</b>	Yes, you can also enter with proof of recovery (recommended form is <a href="https://bit.ly/3JPXo1Q">https://bit.ly/3JPXo1Q</a> ) or with a negative PCR test (72 hours) or negative LFT/antigen test (24 hours).
<b>Other things we need to know?</b>	List of vaccines for entry is different from list of vaccines recognized during stay (to enter restaurants, hotels). Only BioNtech/Pfizer, AstraZeneca (but not Covishield), Johnson & Johnson, Moderna and Nuvaxovid (Novavax) are recognized. When in Austria two dose vaccinations are only valid for 180 days (booster remains valid for 270 days).

## ITALY

<b>Is entry possible?</b>	Entry is possible.
<b>Do vaccinated visitors need additional testing?</b>	No, as long as they have been vaccinated by EMA recognized vaccine. Visitors who have not been vaccinated by EMA recognized vaccine need to do a test before entry.
<b>Which vaccinations are approved?</b>	EMA approved vaccines: BioNtech/Pfizer, AstraZeneca, Novavax, Johnson & Johnson, Moderna and Sinovac.
<b>Validity of vaccine?</b>	6 months. If you have been vaccinated more then 6 months before you need to take a booster shot.
<b>What kind of certificate is acceptable?</b>	EU digital certificate or other certificate in English or German that includes same information as EU digital certificate.
<b>Can non-vaccinated guests enter?</b>	Yes, you can enter with recovery or negative PCR test.
<b>Other things we need to know?</b>	Travel pre-clearance (in shape of PLF form) accessible at <a href="https://app.euplf.eu/#/">https://app.euplf.eu/#/</a> has to be filled before entry.
