



ENTRY REQUIREMENTS FOR VISITORS FROM TAIWAN

AS OF: 26 JANUARY 2022

COUNTRIES ARE INTRODUCED IN REVERSE CLOCKWISE ORDER

North from Slovenia, Croatia then South to Albania, North Macedonia and finishing with Romania and Serbia. You will also find Austria and Italy at the bottom of the file.

SLOVENIA

Is entry possible?	Yes, entry is possible for non-essential travel.
Do vaccinated visitors need additional testing?	No, vaccination is sufficient.
Which vaccinations are approved?	Comirnaty (Biontech/Pfizer) or Spikevax (Moderna) or the Sputnik V (Russia's Gamaleya National Centre of Epidemiology and Microbiology) or the CoronaVac (Sinovac Biotech) or the Sinopharm or the Vaxzevria (AstraZeneca) or Covishield (Serum Institute of India/AstraZeneca) or the Covaxin (Bharat Biotech of India) or Janssen (Johnson/Janssen-Cilag) or a combination of two previously listed vaccines.
What kind of certificate is acceptable?	One of bellow: <ul style="list-style-type: none">- EU digital certificate- Digital certificate of third country- Certification of vaccination, vaccine booklet etc are also accepted.
Validity of vaccine?	Same as validity of EU Green Pass (9 months from last dose of two shot vaccines, 270 days for one shot vaccine).
Can non-vaccinated guests enter?	Yes, as long as they have PCR or antigen test or proof of recovery.
Other things we need to know?	PCR and antigen tests from Taiwan are not acceptable. Testing has to be done in EU and a couple of other countries. All visitors need to fill in Passenger locator form (https://app.euplf.eu/#/)

CROATIA

Is entry possible?	Yes, entry is possible for non-essential travel as long as they have proof of accommodation booking.
Do vaccinated visitors need additional testing?	No, vaccination is sufficient.
Which vaccinations are approved?	Pfizer, Moderna, AstraZeneca, Gamaleya, Sinopharm, Serum Institute of India – Covishield, Bharat Biotech – Covaxin, Sinovac – CoronaVac). Should be at least 14 days and not more than 365 days since the last dose.
Validity of vaccine?	Final dose of vaccine must have been received up to 365 days prior to visit. If your last shot was more than 365 days prior your vaccine certificate will not be valid.
What kind of certificate is acceptable?	EU digital certificate or certificate that has the following information included (type of vaccine, number of shots, date of last shot. Must be in English).
Can non-vaccinated guests enter?	Yes, as long as they have PCR (72 hours) or antigen test (48 hours) or proof of recovery.
Other things we need to know?	It is recommended to fill in Passenger locator form (https://entercroatia.mup.hr/)

BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA

Is entry possible?	Yes, entry is possible for non-essential travel.
Do vaccinated visitors need additional testing?	No, vaccination is sufficient.
Which vaccinations are approved?	Pfizer, Moderna, AstraZeneca, Gamaleya, Sinopharm, Serum Institute of India – Covishield, Bharat Biotech – Covaxin, Sinovac – CoronaVac).
Validity of vaccine?	
What kind of certificate is	EU digital certificate or certificate that has the following



acceptable?	information included (type of vaccine, number of shots, date of last shot. Must be in English).
Can non-vaccinated guests enter?	Yes, as long as they have PCR or antigen test. For visitors who arrive from European country (for example from Croatia) the test results is valid for 48 hours. From other countries it is valid for 72 hours. Certificate of overcoming is also sufficient (14 to 180 days).

MONTENEGRO

Is entry possible?	Yes, entry is possible for non-essential travel.
Do vaccinated visitors need additional testing?	No, vaccination is sufficient.
Which vaccinations are approved?	Pfizer, Moderna, AstraZeneca, Gamaleya, Sinopharm, Serum Institute of India – Covishield, Bharat Biotech – Covaxin, Sinovac – CoronaVac).
What kind of certificate is acceptable?	EU digital certificate or certificate that has the following information included (type of vaccine, number of shots, date of last shot. Must be in English).
Can non-vaccinated guests enter?	Yes, as long as they have negative PCR test (72 hours) or antigen rapid test-BAT (48 hours). Positive PCR or antigen test older than 10 days and not older than 6 months.

ALBANIA



Is entry possible?	Yes, entry is possible for non-essential travel.
Do vaccinated visitors need additional testing?	No, vaccination is sufficient.
Which vaccinations are approved?	All vaccines are accepted.
What kind of certificate is acceptable?	EU digital certificate or certificate that has the following information included (type of vaccine, number of shots, date of last shot. Must be in English).
Can non-vaccinated guests enter?	Yes, as long as they have negative PCR test (72 hours) or antigen rapid test-BAT (48 hours) or evidence proving that you have recovered from Covid-19 within the last six months.

NORTH MACEDONIA

Is entry possible?	Yes, entry is possible for non-essential travel.
Do vaccinated visitors need additional testing?	No, vaccination is sufficient.
Which vaccinations are approved?	All vaccines are accepted.
What kind of certificate is acceptable?	EU digital certificate or certificate that has the following information included (type of vaccine, number of shots, date of last shot. Must be in English).
Can non-vaccinated guests enter?	Yes, as long as they have negative PCR test (72 hours) or antigen rapid test (48 hours) or evidence proving that you have recovered from Covid-19 within the 45 previous days.

KOSOVO

Is entry possible?	Yes, entry is possible for non-essential travel.
Do vaccinated visitors need additional testing?	No, vaccination is sufficient.
Which vaccinations are approved?	All vaccines are accepted. You can enter with a single shot, but you need to present negative PCR test or proof of recovery together with single dose.
What kind of certificate is acceptable?	EU digital certificate or certificate that has the following information included (type of vaccine, number of shots, date of last shot. Must be in English).
Can non-vaccinated guests enter?	No, you need to have at least one shot of the vaccine to be able to enter.

ROMANIA

Is entry possible?	Yes, entry is possible (Taiwan is currently not classified as a risk country).
Do vaccinated visitors need additional testing?	Yes, fully vaccinated visitors still need to take PCR test (48 hours).
Which vaccinations are approved?	Romania follows EU regulation. EU approved vaccines are Pfizer-BioNTech, Moderna (mRNA-1273), AstraZeneca/COVISHIELD. Janssen
What kind of certificate is acceptable?	EU digital certificate or certificate that has the following information included (type of vaccine, number of shots, date of last shot. Must be in English).
Can non-vaccinated guests enter?	Entry is only possible if you have proof of overcoming Covid-19 and a negative PCR test.
Other things we need to know?	Current restrictions are in place until the end of January. A couple of smaller land border crossings are closed.

BULGARIA

Is entry possible?	Entry is possible.
Do vaccinated visitors need additional testing?	No, unless you are coming from a red-list country (for example if you come directly from Taiwan you do not need it). Romania is on green list and no additional documents are required, but most European countries are on red list (only EU citizens can enter Bulgaria from red list countries).
Which vaccinations are approved?	Bulgaria follows EU regulation. EU approved vaccines are Pfizer-BioNTech, Moderna (mRNA-1273), AstraZeneca/COVISHIELD. Janssen
What kind of certificate is acceptable?	EU digital certificate or certificate that has the following information included (type of vaccine, number of shots, date of last shot. Must be in English).
Can non-vaccinated guests enter?	Yes, but only if they have negative PCR test or proof of overcoming Covid and come from green or orange list countries.
Other things we need to know?	Entry from red list countries is only possible for EU citizens. Apart from Romania all neighboring countries (Greece, Serbia, North Macedonia and Turkey) are on the red list so Taiwan passport holders can not enter.

SERBIA

Is entry possible?	Entry is possible.
Do vaccinated visitors need additional testing?	Serbia only allows entry from countries with which they have an agreement. Currently there is no agreement with Taiwan so Serbia does not recognize vaccination or proof of overcoming from Taiwan. All vaccinated visitors must present a negative PCR test.
Which vaccinations are	-



approved?	
What kind of certificate is acceptable?	Certificate from Taiwan is not recognized in Serbia.
Can non-vaccinated guests enter?	Yes, you just need a negative PCR test results.
Other things we need to know?	Keep in mind that negative PCR test is required even for vaccinated guests.

AUSTRIA

Is entry possible?	Entry is possible.
Do vaccinated visitors need additional testing?	Yes, unless they have received a booster shot. Visitors who have only received two shots will need to present a negative PCR test.
Which vaccinations are approved?	Austria approves the following vaccinations: BioNtech/Pfizer, AstraZeneca, Covishield, Covaxin, Johnson & Johnson, Moderna, Sinovac, and Sinopharm
What kind of certificate is acceptable?	EU digital certificate or other certificate in English or German that includes same information as EU digital certificate.
Can non-vaccinated guests enter?	No, entry without quarantine is not possible for non-vaccinated visitors.
Other things we need to know?	Travel pre-clearance (in shape of PLF form) is not required for people who have received booster shot.

ITALY

Is entry possible?	Taiwan is on D list, which means that entry is possible without quarantine. In order to enter Taiwan without quarantine you need to present negative PCR (72 hours) or antigen test (24 hours) and EU Green certificate or equivalent certificate showing that you have completed full

	vaccine cycle.
Do vaccinated visitors need additional testing?	Yes, you need to perform PCR (72 hours) or antigen test (24 hours) before entering Italy.
