From wine tasting, 4WD jeep rides, lake rides to traditional and colorful weddings, learn about main activities and events in Macedonia.

1. WINE TASTING



North Macedonia has over 55,000 acres of vineyards and produces over 100,000 tones of wine. Most wines in the region are red wines. The most common local variety are Vranec, Kratosija and Zilavka, but Macedonia also produces more mainstream sorts like Cabarnet Sauvignon and Merlot. And if you want to try something really unique try a glass of Stanusina Crna, a unique variety of local grape, which is capable of producing very high quality wines and is very popular on domestic market, but little known outside of Macedonia.

2. AMARDA LAKE CRUISE



Armada is a modern boat and one of the most comfortable options to enjoy sightseeing of Lake Ohrid. You can take a day cruise to St Naum, night cruise with dinner and for larger groups you can charter the cruise.

3. GALICNIK WEDDING



Said to be Europe's most traditional wedding festival, every year in mid-July a tiny community in North Macedonia celebrates the union of one special couple. Traditionally the wedding lasted for 5 days, but today it is a two day event and a main cultural and tourist attraction. Each year couple from all over North Macedonia enter a competition run by the organizers to be the couple that gets to have a "Galicka" style wedding. In 2021 the event will take place on July 10 and 11.

4. JEEP SAFARI IN GALICICA NATIONAL PARK

If you are in search of something more adventurous you could try the jeep tour in Galicica National Park. There are a variety of tours available and can be tailor made, but if you want to explore the National Park in depth we recommend full day tour of the National Park. As Jeeps can accommodate up to 50 passengers at the same time, so this product is available also for larger groups.

5. LAS VEGAS OF BALKANS



Situated at the country's main border with Greece lies a town of Gevgelija, which is the most popular casino town in North Macedonia. There are several hotels and several casinos in the town and Gevgelija is a great opportunity if you want to add some fun to your itinerary.
